

# Merry Christmas from Grace Life Ministries

As most of you know, since 2002 GLM has brought ministry to hundreds of children and thousands of families in the slums of Visakhapatnam India. The former railroad slums were taken over by the government because the land was needed to expand the rail services. It was almost impossible to describe the slum. It was a cesspool with a large contaminated pond. During monsoons as much as a foot of water could run through the pathways between their makeshift homes. The residents had occupied the slum for 60 years, which was convenient for doing coolie work in the surrounding perimeters, but the lack of hygiene was dismal. Much sickness spread through the community.

Grace Life set up a daycare in the slum and our main leader, Karuna, provided oversight to hundreds of the daycare children. Eventually the railroad required the land for its own use, and the residents had to move to tenements set up by the government outside the city. These were very simple apartments but at least the sewage was no longer a problem. Nevertheless the move caused hardship to family life since the parents now had to travel long distances early in the mornings, coming home late at night to their children. To protect the children in their parents' absence, GLM set up childcares to feed them, gave them constructive activities, and provided safety for them. Over the years we have become close to many of the people living there. During Covid lockdowns GLM fed over 400 families for a full 2 years, an incredible financial miracle. GLM also made Christmas a special time for them with music, skits, gospel stories, and treats. The families greatly enjoyed our presentations and came out in large numbers. Eventually GLM moved the Christmas celebration to the Shining Trust centre where the daycare children and their parents enjoy a feast of chicken biriyani (the traditional Christmas celebration). We also provide gifts to the children, daycare teachers, and staff. Our leaders show the love of Christ and all have a great fun time, something very special to look forward to break up the mundane they face during the year. This Christmas we are again challenged to repeat this tradition and we offer the opportunity to you, our sponsors and donors, to help make this possible, as you have so faithfully done in past years.







### Christmas in Odisha



One of the particularly enjoyable aspects of this ministry is providing gifts of saris, blankets, scarves, jackets, etc. to the village families. Christmas is a perfect time for this. It always brings much blessing and joy to the Odisha villagers. Some of you may remember the report of the huge gathering we had at the passing of the father of three of our main leaders. We had close to 900 people gather at his funeral. All kinds of government officials, families from far away villages, friends, and many political leaders overseeing many villages were included in this number. Also participating were both high and low caste Hindus. It was a very special and unusual event! Our leaders gave a great feast and shared the love of Christ with the crowds from early morning to late at night. All were amazed. Over the meetings there was a wonderful cloud of favour and a strong sense of the Lord's presence. Great friendships we're cemented, family ties once again established, and the miracle of seeing over one hundred villages opened up for ministry. Our leaders now have an open invitation to over 130 villages. We want to keep these doors open and invite all the surrounding villagers to a large gathering to celebrate Christmas and the new year. We want to bring the traditional biriani feast with treats and snacks, plus at this time of year we want to bless our many workers with bonuses, as well as the many widows whom we look after with gifts. It will be an incredible time of sharing, fellowship, fun, and bringing the ministry of the love of Christ. With your help an involvement we can again put this special event on. We will need many to give to make this possible.
